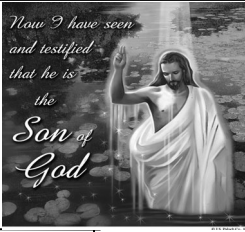
TODAY'S READINGS

Psalm — Here am I, Lord; I come to do your will (Psalm 40).

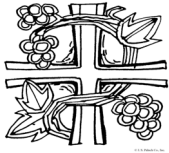
Second Reading — All those who call upon the name of the Lord are called to be holy (1 Corinthians 1:1-3).

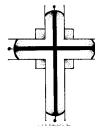
