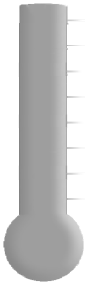
Annual Catholic Appeal

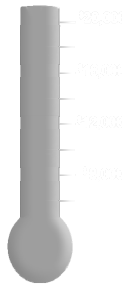
