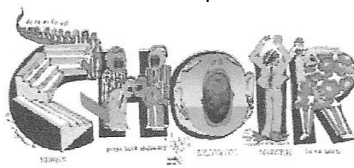

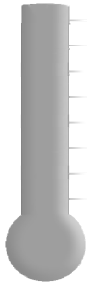
Annual Catholic Appeal

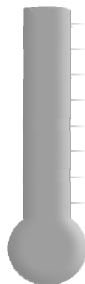


Generations of Faith
