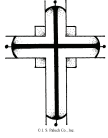

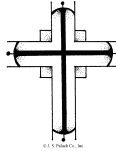

Parish Registration
Why You Need To Register

To all of our parishioners who are still not registered, we respectfully ask that you take just a minute to use the form below and register now. Also, to those parishioners who, for whatever reason, cannot attend mass with us every week, we also ask that you please register with us. You are still part of our parish family and we welcome you. In order to fully participate in our parish, to be always informed about our parish and all of the many, many services and programs we provide, of all the support services available, of all of the events planned--you need to be registered. Also, if you are not registered and you are not using your weekly envelopes, we cannot issue any letters in connection with sponsorship for the Sacraments, we cannot give recommendations for positions, schools, etc. and we also cannot provide letters or documentation confirming your charitable weekly donations in the prior tax years. It is extremely important that you register with our church. It is as simple as filling out one of the WELCOME ENVELOPES in the back of the church or by simply using the form below and giving it to an usher, dropping in a collection basket or by stopping in the rectory office at your earliest convenience.

Religious Education

Registration for Religious Education has begun! Our Religious Education program runs through the school year for children in grades K through 8. Our first day of classes will be on **Sunday, September 22nd, 2019.**

Your child *must* be registered prior to the first day of classes. If your child is *not* registered prior to the first day, they will not be placed into a class until all registration forms are evaluated. Registration forms are available in the rectory and on our parish website. You may come in to the rectory to drop off forms and to register during office hours. Also, all children must have at *least two years* of Religious Education classes prior to receiving a sacrament. Please be diligent in registering your child/children for classes so that they may begin promptly on the first day. For further information or questions, please contact the rectory at (718)236-8300.

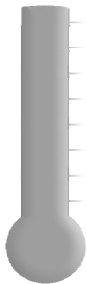
Annual Catholic Appeal

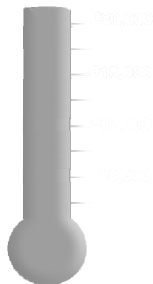


Generations of Faith
