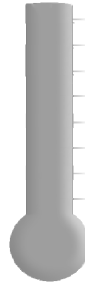

Emergency Blood Shortage! Each blood donation helps save 3 lives!

Our Lady of Guadalupe will be hosting its annual blood drive on Sunday, May 26, 2019 in the Church Basement from 8:45 am – 2:45 pm. Please bring your New York Blood Center donor card, if you have one, as well as picture ID. In order to donate you must weigh at least 110 lbs., and be between the ages of 16-75. If you are 16 years old, you will need parental consent. If you are older than 75, you will need a physician's note stating you are eligible to donate. Please make sure to have a good meal and drink plenty of fluids **PRIOR** to coming to donate. Please set aside an hour for your donation. If you would like to schedule an appointment, please call (800) 933-2566. If you have questions regarding medical eligibility, please call (800) 688-0900.
