To all of our parishioners who are still not registered, we respectfully ask that you take just a minute to use the form below and register now.

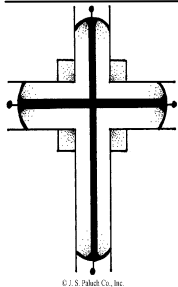
