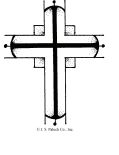
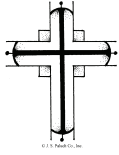

Religious Education

Registration for Religious Education has begun!

Our Religious Education program runs through the school year for children in grades K through 8.

Our first day of classes will be on **Sunday, September 15th, 2019.**

Your child *must* be registered prior to the first day of classes.

If your child is *not* registered prior to the first day, they will not be placed into a class until all registration forms are evaluated. Registration forms are available in the rectory and on our parish website. You may come in to the rectory to drop off forms and to register during office hours. Also, all children must have at *least two years* of Religious Education classes prior to receiving a sacrament. Please be diligent in registering your child/children for classes so that they may begin promptly on the first day.

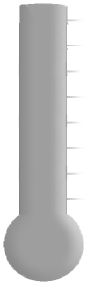
Annual Catholic Appeal

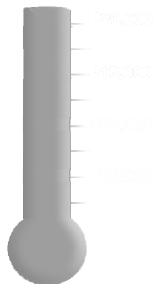
