# Registration Dates

- Sunday, April 6th & Saturday, April 12th (11am-1pm in the rectory office)
- Saturday, May 10th & Sunday, May 18th (11am-1pm in the rectory office)
- Sunday, June 1st (11-1pm in the rectory office)

All campers <u>MUST</u> be registered by Sunday, June 1st, 2025. Registrations after June 1st will be subject to a late registration fee.

**Summer Camp Orientation** will be **Sunday, June 1st at 1:30pm** in the Church Basement (entrance located on 73rd street and 15th avenue)

### **Registration Essentials**

- A copy of your child's Birth Certificate
- Mandatory Signed Forms: Acknowledgment Statement, Registration Form, & Family Tuition Form
- Non-refundable registration fee (\$50 per family/ \$65 for registrations after June 1st)

#### **Emergency Cards**

- All campers MUST have a yellow Emergency card on file. Campers **will not** be permitted to start camp without one on file.
- The card will include: Parent's contact information & will authorize all other individuals allowed to pick up the child from camp.
- ID may be required at pick-up for all members listed.
- Yellow Cards will be available at all registration dates & in the rectory office where forms are available.

## Activity Breakdown

- Our day begins at 9 am, with student arrival by 8:55 am.
- All activities range from approximately 45-55 minutes
- Lunch will begin at 12:00pm for all age groups.
- Each group will participate in the following activities daily:
  - Arts & Crafts
  - Movie Time
  - Indoor Play Time
  - Outdoor Play Time
  - Pool Time
- Pick up begins at 2:45. All students must be picked up by 3pm. All students picked up after 3pm are subject to an extended day fee for the afternoon.
- More specific group schedules will be available closer to the start of camp.

## Early Drop Off Program

The Early Drop Off Program is an additional early-care program for your convenience. The program begins at 8am and runs until 9am.
